What is your repair process and do you receive multiple quotes?
What day will I receive my rent?
About their fees:
Is your commission a flat fee or a percentage of rent collected?
Do you charge commission when the property is vacant?
Do you charge commission on repair costs?
Are inspections covered in your commission?
What fees do you charge for marketing a vacant property?
Do you charge for attending a tenancy tribunal?.
Do you have any other charges?
About their findings service:
What finding fees do you charge tenants?
How do you screen tenants? Do you do credit checks?
How do you advertise your properties?
